

# The TubcuT Process



The first step is to mark the tub. As the customer, you will be asked if you have a location preference. We have done many conversions, so we will be able to help you through this process.

Note that the opening is wider on the left side and there is a definite detail in the side of the tub. You will see that our custom process will allow for a perfect fit. Other approaches use a one-size fits all cap that cannot be adapted to your tub.



The next step is to actually cut out and remove a section from the side of the tub.

It is important to note that everything is covered and there is very little if any mess.

Also, you can keep the piece that we cut out so we can reverse this process if you ever want us to.



Here you can see that three panels have been custom formed to perfectly match the tub surface.

The panels themselves are made of a ½ inch, anti-microbial material that is extremely strong but can be molded and shaped to perfectly match the detail of the tub.



The panels have been integrated into the bathtub structure using an engineered system of metal brackets and an approved, high quality marine grade adhesive system.

The adjoining surfaces are now sanded and molded to match the contours of the bathtub



The opening has been completely sanded and painted.

As you can see, the fit and finish is perfect. The wet paint will blend perfectly when it dries.

# The TubcuT Process



As you can see, the opening is a perfect match to the bathtub. The color shape and detail are perfect.

There is no other process that has such a perfect fit and finish.

Our competition uses a one size fits all cap that is glued on and then caulking is used to fill all of the gaps. Obviously, such a process cannot pick up the detail and shape of your tub. There is really no comparison.

The TubcuT™ process is also reversible. If you keep the piece of the tub that is cut out, we can replace it therefore returning your tub to its original condition. Here again, no other process can accomplish that.
